Oaks Class Recording Weather Data



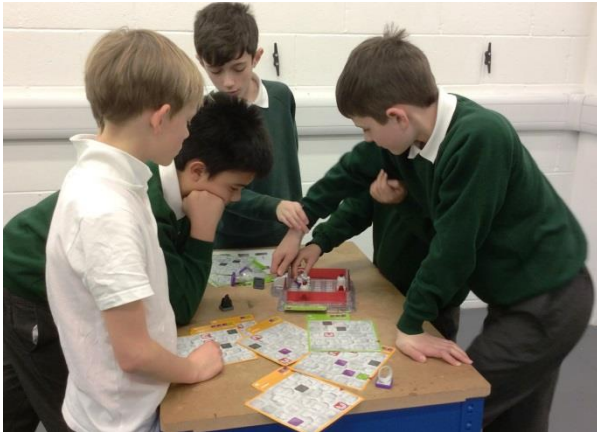
Oaks class using the new rain gauge purchased by FOSS and also the electronic weather station that was installed last year. They are recording data to use in their Computing lessons.

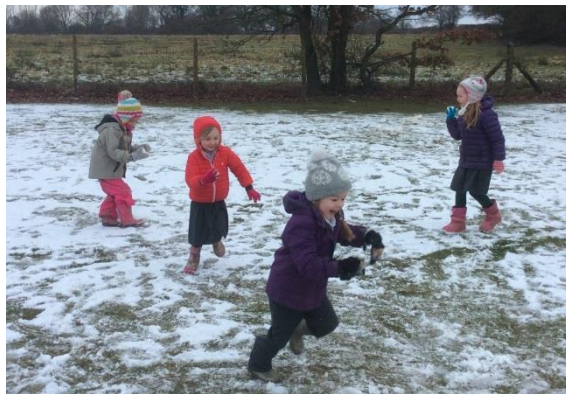


BBC 500 Words Live Lesson
