- Make a model solar system (small)
- Make a rocket/satellite or anything that goes into space
- Find out about food in space and make an astronaut's meal
- Write a story about an astronaut or an alien
- Do a survey to find out the class's favourite planet and make a graph
- How many different stars could you make/draw? They have different numbers of points.
