Over the next few months, children will be mapping and publishing some local walks and interviewing people with their memories of the South Downs.

Looking for somewhere for a local walk with a mystery to solve? Visit the website above and find the mystery photo -

can you identify the building in Slindon? Can you find out what it was used for or write a story about it? There are prizes available! While you are there, have a look in St Mary's church in Slindon where there is a wooden effigy of a knight, nearly 500 years old. Next to the knight is a poem written about him by a nine year-old boy in 1879. Can you find the knight and the poem? What was the name of the boy who wrote the poem? The effigy is of Sir Anthony St. Leger one of the last of the 'true knights of the age of chivalry' - his is the only wooden effigy of its type and age in Sussex and one of only a handful that survive anywhere in the country.

Anti-Bullying week 16th - 20th November

Children will be discussing anti-bullying this week in their classes and in assemblies. The theme this year is 'United Against Bullying' and we will be talking about the role we all play in eliminating bullying. The children will be re-visiting on line safety, particularly keeping personal information safe and the potential risks around X box messaging.
