COVID update

Cases continue to be high in this area and there has been a national increase in the number of 5-9 year olds testing positive. As a school, testing is the best defence we have. While lateral flow tests are useful for flushing out asymptomatic cases, **a PCR test should be sought for a child who has any COVID symptom or has been in contact with a positive case.** This means isolating them until a negative PCR test is confirmed. Thankfully, test results are coming back quickly, minimising disruption. We are truly grateful to our parent community for making sensible and safe decisions.
