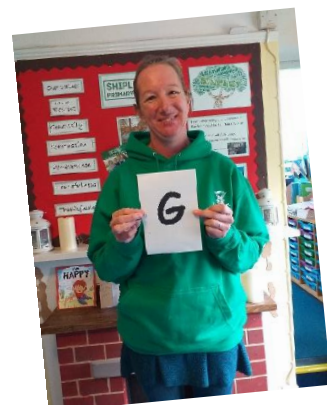
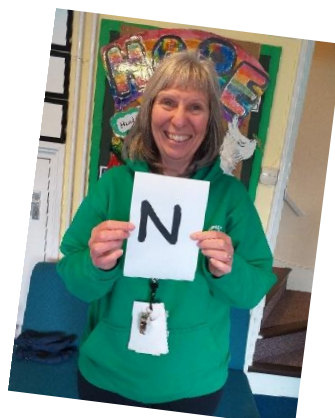

The clubs will start on Monday 19th April. The form will come out next week.

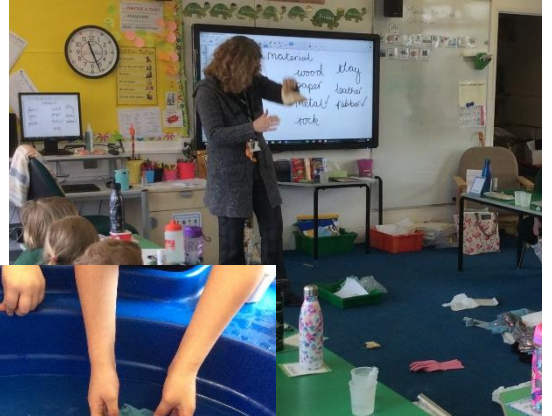
Space in the Early Bird Breakfast Club
