

Flight to Japan



Children have been fully immersed in Japanese culture this week. We have had a visit from Sachiko, a teacher at the Japanese school in Brighton. She showed everyone how to make origami cranes. These are symbolic of hope in Japan. Traditionally, it was believed that making 1000 paper cranes can make your wish come true. Children in Ash and Sycamores have been reading the story of *Sadako and the Thousand Paper Cranes*.

The flight to Japan was a great success. Many thanks to Captain Borie and Richard Killner, one of our governors, for getting into character for the afternoon. Thank you also to Y6 pupils who were amazing in their roles as airport check in, security, passport control, cabin crew and co-pilot. On board, the passengers enjoyed drinks and Japanese snacks and some in-flight entertainment. Some passengers fell asleep and were woken up as we went through some turbulence. The afternoon ended with a Japanese tea ceremony in Ash's new garden.

We are very grateful to the Japan Society who provided us with a grant to purchase Japanese food, books and resources to enhance our learning.



Sycamores Home Learning - School Comms

An email was sent to parents this week, detailing the tasks and where to find them. As part of the transition to Year 7, pupils in Year 6 need to get into good habits of organising their school work at home. It can come as a shock to some children in Year 7 if they do not develop these independent learning skills. Children are expected to read at home every day and this needs to be recorded in their Reading Diary.

Covid-19 Symptoms

If your child shows any Covid symptoms - these continue to be the symptoms to stay alert for:

- High temperature or fever
- New and continuous cough
- A loss or change to taste and smell

If symptoms are experienced, book a PCR test as soon as you can. The whole household must then isolate, including siblings, for 10 days or until a negative test is returned.

Any test results must be shared with the school before pupils can return to school.

The Lateral Flow Test Kits are only for regular testing of people with no symptoms.
