Plastic Free schools Award

School Council have been working hard to promote the message about reducing single use plastic in lunchboxes, items like Dairy Lea Dunkers or any other food items with excessive food packaging. So far, they have been really successful in changing habits and Ash class are particularly well on the way with this. The latest survey showed the vast majority of pupils in Ash have re-useable pots. Interestingly, it also seems to encourage healthier eating; many of the pots contained fruit, crunchy vegetables, hummus and healthy sandwiches. Well done to the children and families who have supported this.

We are now signed up to the Plastic Free Schools Award, in conjunction with Surfers Against Sewage. There is a short video that explains the plastic problem and the aim of the scheme.
