The Weald Inter Schools Football Festival

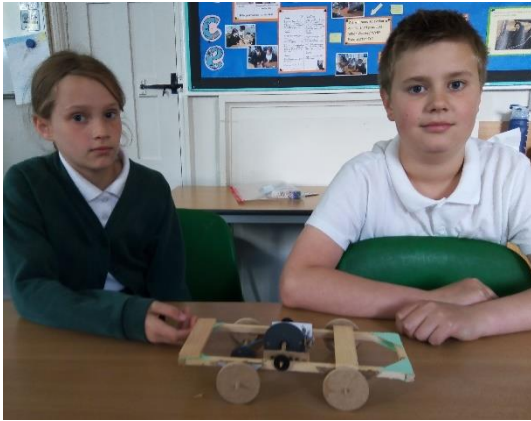


Well done to the Shipley football team who competed at the football festival at The Weald yesterday.
