COVID Update

Cases have slowly begun to rise across the County and we need to remain cautious and vigilant. In addition to the vaccination programme, one of the ways we can be vigilant is by regular asymptomatic testing of staff and parents using the lateral flow tests.

Lateral flow tests are only for **regular asymptomatic testing of adults and secondary age children** and are NOT designed to be used on children under 12.

If a child under 12 has any symptom, they should go straight to a PCR test.

Any family member who shows **symptoms** should take a **PCR test** and the **whole family** must isolate until a **negative test** result is confirmed.

Please **DO NOT** send your child into school if:

- They have **any** COVID symptom, even if you think it is just a common cold
- They have a family member who has symptoms and is awaiting a negative PCR result
- They have returned from an red/amber list country and need to quarantine
