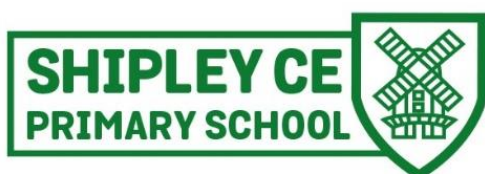


We have two students with us till the end of term. We are delighted to have Miss Emily Whelan and Miss Ellie Coleman working in Oaks Class.
