Maths	<p>Y1 - Fractions, time, multiplication and division, position and direction, place value (within 100), money. Y2 - Fractions, time, statistics, position and direction.</p>	
Science	<p>Plants to include how they grow, planting and observing over time, learning about a variety of plants and trees, and the structure of plants. Animals including humans, to include offspring, basic needs, animal structures and the human body. Scientific enquiry.</p>
