Our topic is Japan and the Olympics



Maths

- Form all your numbers correctly
- Use Sumdog and Times Tables Rockstars apps
- Count to 10, 20 and 100
- Count on and back - add and take away using number lines
- Learn your 2, 5 and 10 times tables - can you find 4 number sentences to go with each one, eg:
 $3 \times 2 = 6$ $2 \times 3 = 6$ $6 \div 3 = 2$ $6 \div 2 = 3$
- Find fractions - half, quarter, thirds - find fractions of numbers
- Do a maths investigation on Japan - how far away is it? What are the favourite foods - make a chart or graph to show this - What are the favourite Olympics sports? Make a chart or a graph to show what you have found out.

Phonics/Spelling

- Continue to use Speed Sounds 1, 2 and 3 cards and learn the sounds
- Keep practising letter formation to ensure all letters are formed correctly
- Use your Teach Your Monster to Read login and see how far you can go
- Do the activities that go with your weekly spellings - put your spellings into sentences about Japan and the Olympics



JAPAN AND THE OLYMPICS



English

- Write a fact list about Japan - display what you have found out - you could make a poster, a fact file, write a story, write a poem, make a book, make a powerpoint, make a film
- Write a poem about Japan or the Olympics using your speed sounds and spellings
- As we learn about Japan, use this information to write a diary as if you were visiting for the first time.
- Write a diary about what you do at home

Topic/Science/Art/DT

- Make a car, truck or train - give it wheels and make it go as fast as you can - test it out on different surfaces
- Find out about Science and engineering in Japan - bullet trains and bridges - the Olympic Stadium
- Make a miniature Japanese garden
- Paint a Cherry blossom picture
- Make a cherry blossom tree from junk
- Find out about waves and paint your own version of Hokasi waves
- Find out about volcanoes/mountains and make Mount Fuji
