## **Oaks multi-skills Event**

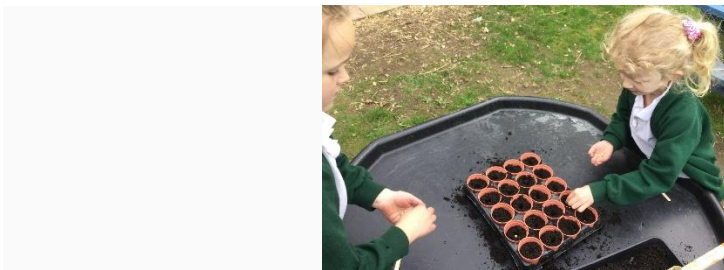
