What's Inside a Flower?



This week we are going to look closely at flowers. What's inside them? What does each part of the plant and flower do?

Go outside into your garden or go for a walk and pick some flowers. Remember it is illegal to pick wild flowers so choose your flowers carefully. If you prefer you could buy some in a shop and use those.

Pick a flower with a stem. Take them back inside or if it's nice enough you could do all of this outside. Look closely at your flower.

What can you see inside?

Use as many adjectives as you can to describe what you can see. Remember your capital letters and full stops too.



Are all the flowers the same?

What's the same and what's different?

Now carefully pull your flower apart and put each of the parts onto a piece of paper.

Use the label below to label your different parts.

stem

roots

leaves

flower

anther

pistil

stamen

petal

sepal

Now you have your flower in different parts you can sing the flower song to learn about what each part does. You will learn about the parts of a flower when you go up to Key Stage Two but I thought some of you might like to know what the parts of a flower are.

Art/DT task - now comes to fun, messy part. You are going to create your own flower/plant with a flower. Use the resource to give you some ideas of what to do. Use junk to model, paint to decorate - anything you want. Have fun and see who can create the loveliest flower. When it's all finished use your labels to label your parts. You could write a description of your flower too.
