Winter

Dark grey shorts or trousers
Grey skirt/grey trousers or grey pinafore
White shirt or blouse
Dark green sweatshirt/cardigan
Plain grey, black or white socks or dark green tights
Plain black school shoes

Summer

Dark grey shorts or trousers
Green and white striped dress (optional)
White polo shirt
Plain sandals that protect toes

PE

Shoes: Indoors - black plimsolls Outdoors -Trainers
Green school shorts and green T-shirt
Sweatshirt/hoodie and/or grey/green tracksuit
PE bag (from school office)

Additional items

Forest School kit
Summer sun hat
Painting apron or shirt
Wellington boots – needed often
