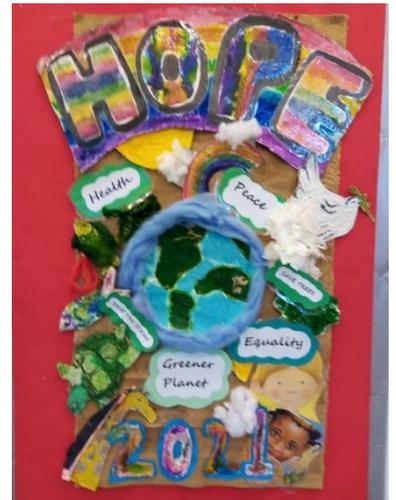

## Ash





Keep up the good work Ash class, we are all very proud of you.





## Oaks
