Can you add speech marks?</p> | <p>Can you draw or make an underwater seascape? Is it a cold ocean with icebergs and polar bears or a warm, tropical sea with a coral reef? What sea creatures live there? Can you describe it using exciting adjectives?</p> | <p>Use books and the internet to research your favourite sea creature. Can you present it in a fun way? Can you present it as a Fact File or PowerPoint? Can you find several fascinating facts? Remember to label pictures and use the headings: Size, Diet, Habitat and Appearance.</p> |
| <p>Find out some fascinating facts about a sea-based topic that interests you. Could you find out about why lighthouses or submarines were used? Alternatively, could you find out about a famous ship? Could you find out what a free diver is? Could you find out how to scuba dive? How can you share this with the class?</p> | <p>How can we stop plastic getting into the sea? Why is water so important? Can you design a powerful poster to help others care for the ocean or help save water?</p> | <p>Read a book about the sea or an animal that lives in the ocean. Is it fiction or non-fiction? What do you like about it? Can you write a book review?</p> |
| <p>Find out about global warming and the impact on the Earth. Share your research with the class. How can we, as a class, help? Can we make changes? Find out!</p> | <p>Go on a beach walk with an adult. What things can you find? Can you see any signs of wildlife? What does the sea sound like? Is it a sandy or a pebbly beach?
