**End of Key Stage 2 Academic Results 2019**

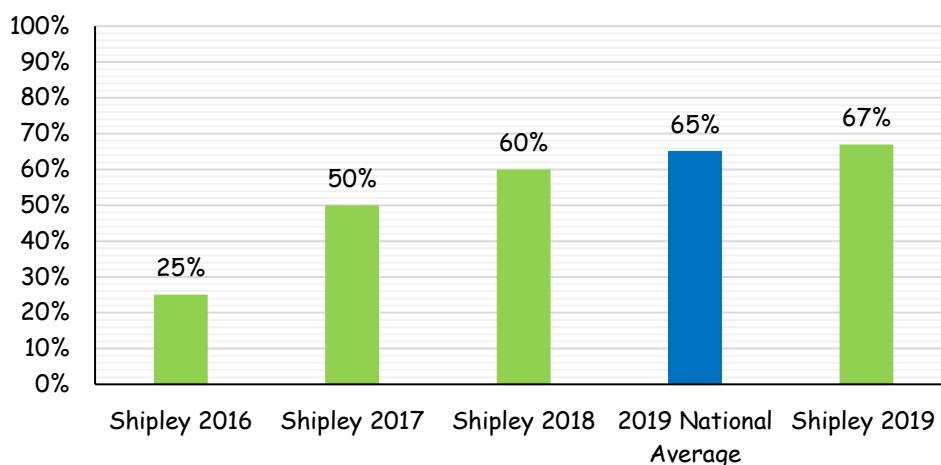
These results are based on a cohort of 3 children where each child holds a value of 33%.
